*A. Key Policy Committee Issues to be considered by NAR and/or the Board of Directors*

### 1. Federal Taxation

*a. Modify Existing Policy on Withdrawals from Special Savings Accounts*

Federal Taxation is expected to consider a motion modifying current policy to also include withdrawals from special savings accounts for first time home purchases persons besides the account owners such as relatives (e.g. children, grandchildren, parents, or others).

*b. Incentives to Sell Single Family Rental Homes*

Federal Taxation may consider a motion to “simplify & consolidate” current policy by replacing earlier policy motions with the goal to create more inventory of homes for sale by encouraging owners of single-family rental homes to sell to owner-occupants through “tax incentives of all types including but not limited to tax credits, deductions, exemptions, and reduced rates.”

### *c. Bonus Depreciation*

Federal Taxation committee may consider a motion to modify existing policy on bonus depreciation or partial expensing.

## **1. Professional Standards Committee**

The Professional Standards Committee is proposing amendments to the Code of Ethics and Arbitration Manual. C.A.R. held an MLS and Professional Standards virtual briefing on Tuesday June 9 to address all questions regarding proposed changes.

## **2. Legal Action Committee Recommendations**

a. To remove oversight of the NAR Professional Liability Insurance Program and the NAR trademark protection program from the Committee's Purposes section of the Committee's governing document, the Legal Action Committee Statement of Organization and Procedure.

b. To add language to the Legal Action Statement of Organization and Procedure addressing the committee's consideration of opportunities for NAR to participate in cases as amicus, effective in 2027, following the sunset of the Amicus Brief Advisory Board, a subcommittee of Legal Action.

c. To recommend a procedural change to the Legal Action Statement of Organization and Procedure permitting committee leadership, in consultation with NAR staff, to summarily deny funding request that 1) are not supported by a local or state association; 2) involve support of a party highly unlikely to prevail; or 3) involve litigation that will only affect the particular litigants.

d. To amend the Legal Action Committee Statement of Organization and Procedure to make ministerial revisions reflecting the 2023 changes to NAR's governance approval structure, and increasing from \$25,000 to \$50,000 the threshold requiring Executive Committee approval for funding recommendations considered during special meetings.
